Business is starting to move at the Legislature.

ACDHH is going through all bills that have been introduced so far to identify any impacts on the communities we serve and ACDHH business.

Committee hearings in House and Senate are happening now. Committee agendas will start to hear

more bills.

ACDHH bill SB 1092 was first read this week and assigned to committee, Senate Health and Human Services.

**HB 2454: Telehealth; Health Care Providers; Requirements**
